Saturday night banquet with speaker and smaller auction of speaker's daylilies



- Named cultivars only no seedlings or unknown plants.
- Mark your plants and/or containers clearly so they get labelled correctly.
- If you know you have jumping worms, please do not donate.
- To minimize the risk of possibly spreading invasive jumping worms, please rinse most of the soil off at your location before packing up to bring to the dig. Plan to have your plants to Circle C Ranch on June 1st by 10 a.m.
- Email the names of what you are bringing to Dawn Bryant as soon as possible or no later than May 24, so the information can be pulled together for the tags. I will need approx. number of fans as we get closer to the sale. I may also need a picture if one cannot be found on the AHS site.


