### DIG

This year our Dig will be hosted by Jolly Steffenhagen at the Steffenhagen Farm in Red Wing on Saturday, May 20:

32300 Hill Avenue Trail, Red Wing, MN 55066 Directions: Highway 61 south through Red Wing, turn left on Hill Avenue Trail, which is about 5 miles south of Red Wing. The farm is about 2 1/2 miles on the gravel road on the right-hand side.

The Dig is a great way to meet the members of our club and make some new friends or greet some old ones. There will be multiple jobs: digging, washing, dividing, and putting labels on. We will break for lunch and the plant adoption distribution.

### Please donate daylilies for the sale!

We need all the plants we can get to make the sale a profitable one for our Club. Plants to the public sell best in the \$5 to \$15 range; so save your more expensive plants for the Auction and Banquet in August and the Regional Meeting in July.

- Plants need to be of named varieties; no seedlings or unknown plants.
- Make sure you mark your plants and/or containers well when you bring them so they can get the correct labels attached to them.
- Plants will be cleaned and divided at the Dig, but any cleaning you can do beforehand is greatly appreciated. Plants must be delivered to Jolly's Farm no later than noon on Saturday.
- ♦ Send your list of donated plants to Jenn Lanz as early as possible. Deadline to submit your list is Monday, May 15, so Jenn has time to make the labels, using the Club's labeling machine. Please also let Jenn know the number of divisions you will have of each variety. But the cultivar name is most important to program into our labeling machine in advance.

♦ If there is not a photo of the variety you are donating on the AHS website, please email one of your own photos to Jenn *ahead of time* so she can print the photo on card stock. The plants always sell better, especially to the public, with a picture!

### **SALE**

Our Sale will be at Bachman's in Edina in the Heritage Room on Sunday, May 21.

Volunteers are needed beginning at 8 a.m. for setup. Our Sale opens to the public at 9 a.m. and goes until 2:30 p.m., or until we sell out of plants. Clean up takes about one hour after the sale ends.

We will draw "parent" applicant names--one at a time--to choose a plant to adopt. Those who are not able to make it to the Dig will have another chance the next day at the Plant Sale at Bachman's, where we will draw for the remaining daylilies at Noon. For the best plant choices, plan to be there on Friday—and be sure to bring some donations for the Plant Sale!

You may designate someone to pick out your daylily for you if you are not able to make it either day. A complete list of all cultivars up for adoption will be emailed to adoptive parents before the Dig to give you time to study up on your choices!
