


Norma 'Jean' Hjellming

- To minimize the risk of possibly spreading invasive jumping worms, please rinse most of the soil off at your location before packing up to bring to the dig. Plan to have your plants to the Lidinsky's on June 3th by 10 a.m.
- Email the names of what you are bringing to me (Dawn Bryant) as soon as possible or no later than May 22, so the information can be pulled together for the tags. If you know the approx. number of fans it would be appreciated if you include that.

The DIG & PREP: Come and work as long as you are able.

DIG & Prep (many clumps); there will be many jobs washing, dividing & labeling.


