

Saturday, May 18 @ **9:00** am. Location: home of **Bill and Dory Lidinsky: 2841 147th Ave NE, Ham Lake Minnesota.** There are multiple jobs: washing, dividing, and labeling. We need all the help we can get: come for a short period of time or spend the day. This is a great way to meet new friends or greet old ones. We will break around lunchtime. We will not be digging at the Lidinsky's.

PLEASE donate some plants!



We need all the plants we can get to make the sale a profitable one for our club. Plants for the public sell best in the \$5 to \$25 range. Plan on having your plants to Lidinsky's by 10AM the day of the dig. If you are unable to make the dig, or will arrive later then 10AM, contact Jenn to make arrangements for pick up/drop off.

Donated "cultivars" need to be named varieties—no seedlings or unknown plants. Mark your plants and/or containers well so they can be accurately labeled for the sale. Dug up clumps in labeled trash bags work well. Cleaning and dividing will all be done the day of the dig. Any precleaning of your plants would be greatly appreciated.



NOW is a great time to think about which varieties you would like to divide and donate. Send Jenn an email with the names **NOW**; you can update her with the number of fans **AFTER** you dig. Jenn may need you to supply a photo of the cultivar if she is unable to locate one on the AHS website. Plants sell better with a picture! Jenn will be creating labels and photo cards. Jenn will need all this information: Cultivator name/number of double/triple fans, no later than **noon**, **May 13th**

If you have more expensive cultivars to donate, please inform Jenn. These plants will be placed on the list for the Auction & Banquet in August.

Don Unruh May 9, 1937 – February 22, 2019

The Daylily Society of Minnesota has been blessed to have Don Unruh as a member. We will really miss his kindness, cheerfulness, friendship, support, and service. He was a member of the Board of Directors and Treasurer from 1998-2014, and also handled the books for the regionals in 2000, 2004 and 2011, and the nationals in 2007 and 2013. He helped out at every event, including the dig, sale, off scape show, banquet and auction, and attended every meeting, including science, spring fling and regional events. The only times he ever missed an event was when he was out of town with his family for the bison roundup or a photo shoot. His daughter Leslee Yoder and his wife Darlene made sure he was able to continue to attend even after his mobility became limited.

Don loved photography and traveled the world to take pictures. His excellent photographs were often in the Daylily Pioneer, and he won the AHS photography award in 2008 for Best Clump (Seventy Six Trombones). He especially loved taking pictures of large flowers with big ruffled edges.

Don always had a smile on his face, and I'm sure he gave everyone a good laugh when his garden was on tour in a summer when all the flowers were bloomed out. He printed out and carefully attached a picture of each flower in his garden to the plant to show what the garden would have looked like on a normal summer tour. Our thoughts and prayers are with his family.
